

## 2024 AIDL CONFERENCE: SECOND CIRCULAR

Thanks to financial assistance from the research support program of the Secrétariat du Québec aux relations canadiennes, the International Academy of Linguistic Law, the Université de Sherbrooke, more specifically the Faculty of Law, the Department of Arts, Languages and Literatures, the Centre de recherche sur la régulation et le droit de la gouvernance (CrRG) and the Centre de recherche interuniversitaire sur le français en usage au Québec (CriFUQ), and the Association québécoise de droit constitutionnel (AQDC) organize the :

# 18th International Conference of the International Academy of Linguistic Law Law, languages, indigenous peoples, minorities, fragile majorities and Governance in Québec, Canada and the World June 3-5, 2024, Sherbrooke, Québec, Canada

As mentioned in the first circular, the congress will therefore be an opportunity to reflect on the governance of language policies in the broadest sense, particularly those of official languages in the public sphere and private enterprise, minority languages, indigenous languages or languages associated with fragile majorities. The proposed themes are: State, Community and Official Language(s); Language law and the sphere of private enterprise; Minority language; Language of Indigenous Peoples; Fragile linguistic majority; Language and Education, Terminology, Translation and Governance; Language, standardization and reference tools.

Regarding the registration fees, we are pleased to offer three packages to which you can subscribe until May 1<sup>st</sup> 2024 at 11:59 p.m. (Eastern Standard Time).

• PACKAGE 1 (with accommodation in university residences and transportation)

Package 1 includes access to the three days of the conference (there is no package for a single day or two days), accommodation for 4 nights (from the evening of June 2 to the morning of June 6), travel expenses between Montreal, where the international airport is located, and Sherbrooke (or other reasonable travel expenses within Canada or Quebec), the cruise, three lunches, coffee breaks, and the publication of contributions after a positive review, if applicable. The terms and conditions for collecting and handing over the keys will be communicated to you by the university's hotel service.

- ➤ Registration before March 15th: \$250 CAD all taxes included
- Registration between March 15<sup>th</sup> and May 1<sup>st</sup>: \$300 CAD all taxes included











• PACKAGE 2 (without accommodation, with transportation)

Package 2 includes access to the three days of the conference (there is no package for a single day or two days), travel expenses between Montreal, where the international airport is located, and Sherbrooke (or other reasonable travel expenses in Canada or Quebec), the cruise, three lunches, coffee breaks and publication of contributions after a positive evaluation, if applicable.

- ➤ Registration before March 15: \$175 CAD all taxes included
- ➤ Registration between March 15<sup>th</sup> and May 1<sup>st</sup>: \$200 CAD all taxes included
- PACKAGE 3 (without accommodation or transportation)

Package 3 includes access to all three days of the conference (there is no package for a single day or two days), the cruise, three lunches, coffee breaks and the publication of contributions after a positive evaluation, if applicable.

- Registration before March 15: \$100 CAD all taxes included
- ➤ Registration between March 15 and May 1<sup>st</sup>: \$125 CAD all taxes included

# Transportation from Montreal Airport to the Université de Sherbrooke

For your trips between the Montreal airport and Sherbrooke, you can book a round-trip shuttle between the Montreal airport (YUL) and the main campus of the Université de Sherbrooke (main campus (not health campus) located in Sherbrooke (not Longueuil)). The shuttles have about ten seats and they can drop you off at the foot of the university residences on the main campus of the Université de Sherbrooke. It is recommended that you book your rides at least two weeks before the event.
