## Program goals that reflect new requirements

- Develop functional and managerial knowledge of the sport industry
- Deepen your understanding of ethical principles as they apply to sport
- Develop and implement testing programs and apply the necessary requirements for each situation
- Support athletes or organizations in their public interactions
- Develop strategies to meet the new demands of the sector

## A unique academic track in two languages

The program can be taken in English or French (Diplôme d'études supérieures spécialisées de 2<sup>e</sup> cycle en gouvernance du sport et antidopage).

The main learning modality is distance learning. In person periods at the Longueuil Campus are included to give you direct access to stakeholders in the field, notably experts from the World Anti-Doping Agency. The program is also offered on a full-time or part-time basis.

## Who is this program for?

Anyone with an undergraduate degree in any discipline (as the program is multidisciplinary) and anyone already working who is looking for a career change or a leg up to access positions of responsibility in sport.
