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Description

The course will present English grammar and its rules. Students will learn the rules of grammar and develop a strong understanding of the basics of English grammar. Students will be expected to not only apply grammar rules, but be able to explain them clearly and correct errors made by others. Students will be expected to be able to identify and name the grammar rules.

Content

Strong emphasis will be placed on the understanding and correct usage of all the verb tenses.

Students will study:

- Questions and sentence structures
- Modals
- Conditional sentences
- Passive voice
- Preposition combinations
- Gerunds / infinitives
- Pronouns
- Spelling
- Pronunciation

Procedure

The course will be divided into lectures and exercises. A workshop approach will be used. Students will be taught the rules and then have to apply them. For this reason, class attendance is essential.

Workload

Students will be given grammar exercises every week as well as having to create ways to teach the rules.
