## **ANG 132 INTRODUCTION TO TRANSLATION, French to English**

### **Objectives**

This course is designed to introduce students to the translation of general texts from French into English. Students will learn how to deal with various problems of translation and language that arise in French-English translation. Students will be introduced to dictionaries, reference material and other paper and electronic resources and documentation useful in French-English translation.

### **Content**

- translation of texts of a general nature from French into English
- analysis of specific problems encountered in translation from French to English
- introduction to paper and electronic documentation and resources useful in French-English translation.

### **Procedure**

Class time will be divided between lectures and workshops. Sample translations will be analyzed and criticized. Exercises and translations prepared outside of class will be corrected and discussed. Corrected assignments will be returned to students and reviewed in class. Attendance at class is compulsory.

### **Work Load**

Students will do translation assignments and exercises on a weekly basis. There will be a mid-term as well as a final examination.
