## **ANG 330 SPECIALIZED TRANSLATION, FRENCH to ENGLISH**

### **Objectives**

This course is designed to teach students to translate a variety of specialized non-literary texts from French into English.

### **Content**

- translation of specialized texts from French into English. Texts will be taken from fields such as business, ecology, the social sciences and humanities, and advertising;
- development of research strategies; consultation of paper and electronic resources;
- degrees of specialization; text genres.

### **Classroom Procedures**

Class time will be divided between lectures and workshops. Sample translations will be analyzed and criticized. Translations and exercises prepared outside of class will be reviewed and discussed. Corrected assignments will be returned to students and discussed in class. Attendance at class is compulsory.

### **Workload**

Students will do translation assignments and exercises on a weekly basis. There will be a mid-term as well as a final examination.
