## **ANG 435 LITERARY TRANSLATION, FRENCH TO ENGLISH**

### **Objectives**

This course is designed to introduce students to the translation of literary texts from French into English. Students will learn how to deal with various problems of translation and language that arise in French-English translation of various genres : novels, short stories, poetry, and drama. Approaches to literary translation; free versus literal translation. Style, register, connotation, allusions, word play, fidelity. Audience, effect, intention. Domestication and foreignization.

### **Content**

- translation of a selection of literary texts from French into English
- analysis of specific problems encountered in translation of various genres from French into English
- textual analysis; translation process; revision; critical rereading
- class exercises; group work.

### **Classroom procedures**

Class time will be divided between lectures and workshops. Sample translations will be analyzed and criticized. Translations prepared outside of class will be discussed. Corrected assignments will be returned to students and discussed in class. Attendance at class is compulsory.

### **Workload**

Students will do translation assignments and exercises on a weekly basis. There will be a mid-term as well as a final examination.
