

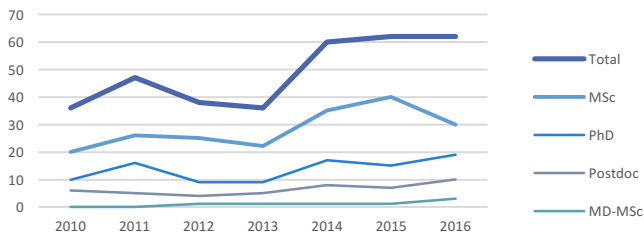

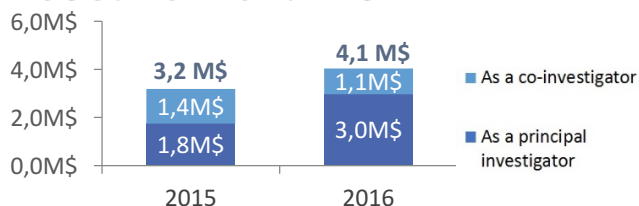

### Accessibility Committee

Implementation of the Advanced Access model  
 within our network of 11 Family Medicine Academic Settings

- 91% introduced the Advanced Access for their clinical preceptors compared to 73% in 2015
- 73% also introduced it for their residents compared to 27% in 2015
