The Ph.D. program also has multiple concentrations including one in imaging and a second in bioinformatics.

The Department includes 20 professors actively involved in the following research areas: artificial intelligence, bioinformatics, health informatics, human-machine interface, imaging and digital media sciences, Internet of things, optimization, pervasive computing, security, formal methods, quantum computing, and theoretical computer science.
