The Department of Pedagogy at the Université de Sherbrooke (UdeS) is seeking applications for the new Strategic Research Chair in University Pedagogy. The aim of this Chair is to develop research on learning in a university context, an area of research that is part of the UdeS's 2022–2025 strategic plan. The successful candidate will have solid expertise in a field or area of study related to learning, such as psychopedagogy, learning sciences, educational psychology, and neuroeducation. In addition to having high-level expertise on current and future issues in university education, the candidate sought should have conducted research into technology-enhanced learning and be open to studying innovative teaching and curricular practices.

The Chair is tenable for five years and renewable. It will initially receive \$1.5 million from the university management priorities fund (Fonds des priorités de la direction universitaire).

Career interruptions

In accordance with the diversity and equity objectives, career interruptions for parental, medical, and family leave will be taken into account when assessing applications. As such, candidates are encouraged to identify such periods in their curricula vitæ or cover letter.



Main duties

- Develop research activities on learning in higher education.
- Supervise graduate students.
- Teach at graduate and postgraduate levels in the field of higher education, particularly in postgraduate programs in higher education pedagogy
- Take part in university life.
- Contribute to community service.

Profile sought

The candidates sought are experienced researchers with an outstanding research record who are recognized by their peers as world leaders in their field.

The following requirements are listed in order of importance and will be used to assess applications.

Requirements

- Doctorate in education or in learning psychology in the field of higher education pedagogy.
- Solid, peer-recognized research experience, including external funding, publication in internationally peer-reviewed journals, and knowledge transfer.
- Expertise in learning, particularly technology-enhanced learning.
- Scientific and pedagogical originality and innovation.
- Experience in interdisciplinary or multidisciplinary research.
- Good ability to supervise graduate students, including postdoctoral fellows.
- Leadership, initiative, and ability to communicate and interact with internal and external partners.
- Knowledge of students and their needs, given the diversity of study programs in a university context.
- Knowledge of the issues and challenges associated with higher education pedagogy in Quebec, North America, and elsewhere in the world.
- Ability to interact and teach in French.
- Experience in integrating information and communication technologies (ICT) into teaching.
- Ability to comply with the requirements of responsible research conduct.
