## REQUIRED PROFILE

Applications are sought from outstanding candidates with training in primary healthcare, public health, community health, epidemiology, health economics, or a related discipline whose expertise will complement the skills and research themes already present at the CFMNB.

The CFMNB is particularly interested in candidates whose research program is related to chronic diseases, aging, mental health, and/or primary healthcare.

- Teach in French in FMSS programs and actively participate in the supervision of residents and postdoctoral trainees.
- Supervise graduate students.
- Develop applied research activities and maintain an externally funded competitive research program.
- Focus teaching and research activities on the priority health concerns of the community, region, and nation, as defined by the FMSS's concept of social responsibility.
- Participate in academic life, in CFMNB activities, and contribute to community service.

The researcher recruited will be expected to develop his or her own scientific niche in collaboration with the institution's researchers. He or she will have to demonstrate originality in the development of a research program related to chronic disease, aging, mental health, and/or primary healthcare.

- Doctoral degree (Ph.D.) in Primary Healthcare, Public Health, Community Health, Epidemiology, Health Economics, or a related discipline.

- Demonstrate skills in establishing and maintaining good interpersonal relationships, a sense of collaboration with clinicians, and teamwork skills.
- Ability to teach in French or reach this ability quickly (2 years).
- Postdoctoral experience in related fields.
- Experience in applied research in primary health care or population health is an asset.
- Proficiency in epidemiological concepts and methods in health research and biostatistics.
- Demonstrate excellent teaching and undergraduate and graduate student training skills.
- Demonstrate strong leadership skills in the supervision of graduate students.
- Demonstrate a good understanding of trends in research funding in Canada.
- Strong interest and aptitude for research, development, and knowledge mobilization.
- Demonstrate leadership, innovation, and excellent abilities to communicate and interact effectively and harmoniously with various internal and external partners, within the Province of New Brunswick, across Canada, and internationally.
